Lodge is only 5 miles from the Kenai Airport. Spurr, you can charter a boat for some heavy-duty halibut, whale watch, clam, explore quaint little Alaskan towns where you could end up at the end of the road...

The city of Kenai is at the mouth of the Kenai River on Cook Inlet. 130 miles or a 30 minute flight south of Anchorage and 80 miles north of Homer and Seward. All roads into Kenai are well paved and incredibly scenic.
